Qualifying Connection

All couples have to legally qualify to get married in a church. Please choose from the following:

Resident	I have had my usual place of residence in the parish for at least 6 months
Baptised	I was baptised in the parish (by a Church of England service/form of baptism)
Confirmed	I have been confirmed (by a Church of England service) and my confirmation is entered in a register belonging to a church or chapel in the parish
Parent Marriage	My parent or grandparent was married in the parish by a Church of England service
Parent Resident	My parent has had his or her usual place of residence in the parish for at least 6 months during my lifetime
Habitually Attended	I have habitually attended public worship at Church of England services in the parish for at least 6 months
Parent Attended	My parent has habitually attended public worship at Church of England services in the parish for at least 6 months during my lifetime

Banns

Banns must be published on three Sundays within the three calendar months preceding the date of the marriage.

At least seven days notice is required before the reading of the first banns.

Banns must be published in the parishes where each partner resides as well as in the parish where the marriage is to take place.

Statutory fees are payable to each of the parishes where banns are to be published.

Before the marriage can take place, the incumbent or officiating minister must have received the "Certificate of Banns" from all other parishes involved.

It is the responsibility of the couple to ensure that banns are published in the correct parishes and that certificates are collected and delivered.

Changes to Details

Any changes to the details provided overleaf should be notified to the incumbent as soon as possible and a new form completed if necessary.

Divorcees

If you have been married before, then a Decree Absolute must be provided before a wedding can be booked.

Examples of ID Documents

Passport, Driving Licence, Utility Bill, Bank Statement, Birth Certificate

Originals must be provided, so that copies can be made and certified. These will be kept by the church.
